## Points of Pride

- Class of 2020 earned over \$27 million in scholarships and grants.
- In the last two years, Roman students have been accepted to prestigious institutions including Colgate, Boston College, UPENN, University of Texas, Dallas, Vanderbilt and Notre Dame. 95% of graduates attend post-secondary education at college and universities both locally and nationally.
- Over the past year, Roman has two National Merit Semifinalists and a National Merit Scholarship Award Winner.
- Members of the student body represent over 175 different elementary schools coming from 90 different zip codes throughout the Delaware Valley.
- Current academic partners include The Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, the Philadelphia Museum of Art, La Salle University, Museum of the American Revolution.
